that do not involve specialized research or travel needs will be set at \$500. All faculty are eligible for course development grants. Typically, expenditures fall into the categories listed below.

- 1. Research assistance
- 2. Travel essential to the gathering of material for a specific research or teaching project
- 3. Tuition or registration for workshops related to pedagogical innovation

Please note the types of expenditures that are not likely to be funded:

- 1. Travel to a sabbatical site
- 2. Meals at a research site
- 3. Professional books and subscriptions
- 4. Professional society membership fees
- 5. General clerical help

Guidelines

The following guidelines and procedures apply to faculty enrichment grants:

- 1. Applications must be complete and include necessary signatures.
- 2. Submissions after the deadline will not be considered.
- 3. Priority will be given to faculty who have not received research or course development funds in the past.
- 4. Faculty on sabbatical leave are eligible to apply for enrichment grants.
- 5. Funds must be used by June 30 of the fiscal year awarded.
- 6. Expense reports for reimbursement are due within 30 days of the close of the funding period and must
